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Warranty

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CYCLE WARRANTY CRITERION: One "cycle" is considered one open and one closure of the shutter. DSS Shutter must be operated with the ED12DSS driver or equivalent H-Bridge type shutter driver circuit at +10.7VDC across the actuator coil for the specified duration. DSS Shutter must be operated within the defined environmental, electrical and mechanical specifications as listed on the device's data sheet. After one year (WARRANTY PERIOD), the cycle warranty is null and void. If returned, the device must be accompanied by a written statement indicating the approximate number of cycles contained on the device, include all parameters to which the shutter was operated and follow the RETURN MATERIAL AUTHORIZATION PROCEDURE as defined below.

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Introduction

The #21 mount set adapts specific shutter housing types to a Zeiss type microscope configured with the Zeiss type Axiovert Ring Dovetail Mounts. No modification to the microscope should be necessary. A filter area is also provided to allow the user to install an optical filter between the light source and the shutter housing.

Assembly Procedure

Mount Assembly

Unpack the Mount Set

As you remove the packing material from the box, check for small items that may be attached to the packing material. Make sure the following parts were included in the box:

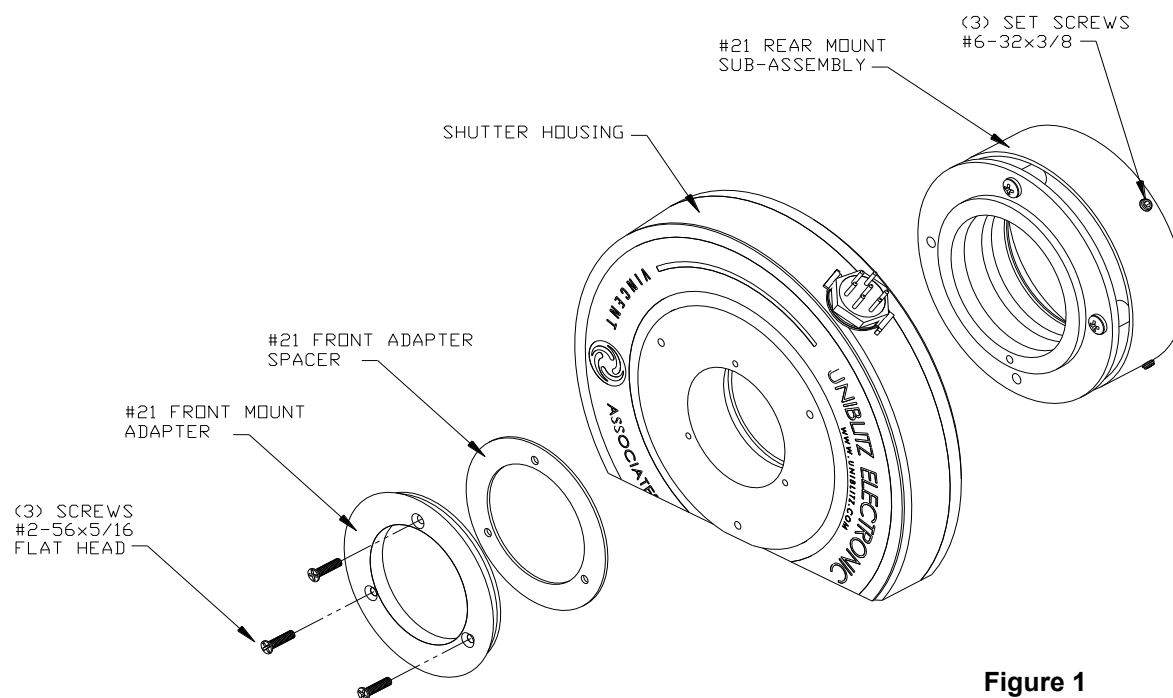

INSTALLATION STEPS:

Step One:

Using (3) 2-56 flat head screws attach #21 front mount and front spacer* to the front of the shutter housing.
(see Figure 2) *Front spacer may be omitted for attachment to transmitted halogen lamp-housing.

Step Two:

Screw the rear mount sub-assembly to the back of the shutter housing, tighten securely.

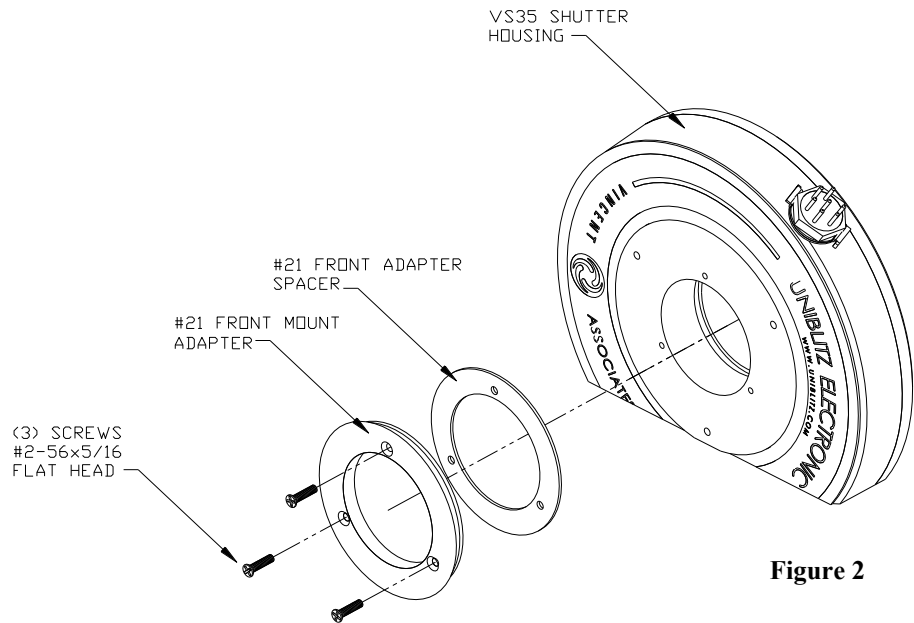
